## The Great Invocation

To bring about world betterment at this most challenging time in human history tasks common good leaders with overcoming their prejudices, pride, ambition, feelings of futility, and aspirational fixations to recognize similarities of objectives, ideals, and methods, permitting effective collaboration where possible and ensuring harmlessness to all. Such dedicated world servers exist in every nation, government, political party, religion, race, ethnicity, and class. Their massed intent has yet to be fully mobilized for the helping of humanity. Group consciousness must unite us to renewed spiritual efforts to bring about the restoration demanded by the masses everywhere.

People around the world, when rightly taught, learn to distinguish and bridge the gap between the self-oriented personality and its higher counterpart, the group-oriented soul. Still, higher development exists, but for most human beings, the immediate possibility is becoming a soul-infused personality: an individual self-aware and oriented to the common Good.

The Great Invocation is a world prayer first released by Djwahl Kuhl, a Tibetan teacher and Master of the Wisdom, in 1945 to aid humanity's recognition of the spiritual Hierarchy of our planet and those perfected "sons of God who are also sons of men" who, throughout many ages and civilizations, have inspired, illuminated, and led humanity onward. It has been translated into almost seventy languages and dialects and used by millions. In practice, it is a universal spiritual project that includes people of all faiths and those motivated by humanitarian ideals. It is an act of service to humanity.

Participants use the Great Invocation in a spirit of cooperation and selfless service to stimulate and increase the flow of light and goodwill worldwide. Through its repeated use, a dual integration-fusion process blends personality and soul within an individual, group, or nation while synthesizing each within the greater whole. It expresses certain central truths: that an essential Intelligence is guiding the universe, working out Its Purpose (the Great Good) through Love, which motivates and implements the divine Plan (the Good) through humanity, which Christ most fully embodied.

Another aspect of the potency of this group work rests in the fact that the invocation should be used and sounded as *voiced demands* and *affirmed beliefs*. The Ancient Wisdom tells us that this invocation breaks the impasse between good and evil, light and dark, and between a return to the materialistic past and a more divine future. Still, the guarantee of a better tomorrow must come from a sensed vision that dawns upon the minds of human beings throughout the world so that they will choose to allow even more light and love into their minds, transforming their thoughts and actions. To this, each of us can add our efforts in just a few minutes each day.

From the point of Light within the Mind of God
Let light stream forth into human minds.
Let Light descend on Earth.
From the Point of Love within the Heart of God
Let love stream forth into human hearts.
May the Coming One return to Earth.
From the center where the Will of God is known

From the center which we call the human race
Let the Plan of Love and Light work out
And may it seal the door where evil dwells.
Let Light and Love and Power restore the Plan on Earth.
